(b) Search and Identification Permit. The following permit shall be used for search and identification permission:

The Alabama Historical Commission (Commission) grants an exclusive cultural resources Search and Identification Permit to _____ (Permittee), for the purpose of conducting systematic search procedures and diving as may be necessary to locate and identify the _____ with the following stipulations.

This permit shall be valid only for the area described below:

No excavation, boring, or alteration of the site with the exception of hand fanning shall be conducted unless specifically approved by the Commission through a written amendment to this stipulation, attached to this permit.

No artifacts either attached or loose shall be retrieved without a specific amendment to this permit requested and approved by the Commission in writing.

This permit shall be valid for six (6) months effective on a date agreed upon by the Commission and the Permittee. A six (6) month extension may be granted by notifying the Commission, in writing, of the need for the extension and an explanation of the reasons for this need.

The Permittee shall allow, upon reasonable notice, Commission staff or their agents access to facilities and search activities.

The Permittee shall provide the Commission a map and description of the site and debris field (if any) upon completion of this permit activity.

A monthly progress report shall be provided by the Permittee to the Commission.
